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- **Retrospective entries by Surgeons - Implications for PROMs**

**For BREAST PROMs**

1. If the Date of operation is less than 12–15 months at retrospective Date of data entry into the flap registry by the user, the 6 months PROMs email will be sent. The 18 months Proms email will be then sent routinely at the appropriate time-triggered point.
2. If the date of operation is over 18 months at the time of data entry into the registry, then only the 18 months Proms email link will be sent.

**For LOWER LIMB PROMs**

1. If date of operation is less than 9 months at the time of retrospective data entry into the registry by the surgeon, then the 9 months email link for Lower Limb Proms will be sent at the appropriate time point.
2. If the date of operation is over 9 months at the time of data entry into the registry, then the 9 months link will be sent immediately.

- **Production of Unit publication report: Costs**

1. UKNFR Report with 3 years Unit data on flaps, similar to attached National Waldenstrom Macroglobulinaemia Registry Report: £12,000-£13,000.
2. 200 copies of a glossy book for distribution to Chief Executives: £700-£1000. Once the print run is setup, production of extra copies becomes cheaper.
